Students will explore different styles and genres of Music from around the world, and develop practical skills through singing, keyboards and ukuleles. Students will also compose their own music, developing their creative voice and ability to express ideas. Students will learn to critically evaluate different styles of Music by using musical elements of increasing complexity.

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Y10 Students will be completing the NCFE V Cert First Award in Music Technology, learning how to understand and use music technology to create their own music, as well as developing awareness of song structures, general music theory and an understanding of the functions of the music industry. Students will spend Y10 learning and preparing for their examination year in Y11.
