	Yardleys School is currently a secondary school that admits children at age 11 and who leave age 16.	
	If there are more applications than places available in any year group the following oversubscription criteria will be applied:	
Criteria	1. Looked after or previously looked after children.	
	 Children with a brother or a sister already at the school who will still be in attendance in September 2026. 	
	3. Children who live nearest the school.	
	Within each of these categories, priority is given to those who live nearest the school, calculated on the basis of a straight-line measurement between home and school.

Sibling	children who live at the same address and either: i. have one or both natural parents in common; or ii. are related by a parent's marriage;

Distance	Distances are calculated on the basis of a straight-line measurement between the applicant's home address from the centre of the school. The Local Authority uses a computerised system, which measures all distances in metres. Ordnance Survey supply the co-ordinates that are used to plot an applicant's home address and the main entrance of the school.	
Shared Responsibility		
Final Qualifier	In a very small number of cases it may not be possible to decide between the applications of those pupils who are the final qualifiers for a place, when applying the published admission criteria.	
	For example, this may occur when children in the same year group live at the same address, or if the distance between the home and academy is exactly the same, for example, blocks of flats. If there is no other way of separating the application according to the admissions criteria and to admit both or all of the children would cause the Published Admission Number for the child's year group to be exceeded, the Local Authority will use a computerised system to randomly select the child to be offered the final place.	
	In the event of this occurring with twins or other multiple birth applicants, schools will be asked to admit over their Published Admission Number to accommodate the pupils.	
Waiting Lists	Waiting lists will not be fixed following the offer of places. They are subject to change. This means that a child's waiting list position during the year could go up or down. Any applicants will be added to the school's list in accordance with the order of priority for offering places. Waiting lists will be maintained until the end of each academic year.	
Appeals	Appeals are administered by the Local Authority for this Academy. Parents who wish to appeal against the decision to refuse their child admission should visit www.birmingham.gov.uk/schooladmissions

The Governing Body has this power, even when admitting the child would mean exceeding the published admission number subject.
