Re: Extreme warm weather arrangements

As you may be aware the Met Office have issued a 'red' extreme heat warning for parts of England. In anticipation of this unprecedented weather, we have planned the following adjustments for the health and safety of our students and staff on Tuesday 23rd, Wednesday 24th and Thursday 25th June 2026.

School Day

- **School will start at its normal time at 8:40 am but will finish at 12:30 pm.** There will be no detentions or after school clubs.
- The Main Hall, Cooper Hall and atrium will be available at break time for students who wish to stay inside. The canteen will not be serving any hot food to avoid ovens being on and increasing the heat flow in the building. There will be a cold food provision.
- Please encourage your child to bring water.
- PE lessons will be adapted due to the extreme weather conditions.

School uniform

- Students can come to school in school uniform without a tie, jumper or blazer.
- Hats and caps will be allowed for outside use only.

Year 10

- Due to the weather, JCC have cancelled the visit on Thursday 25th June.
- Year 10 exams will continue this week with the following changes –
 - Geography exam on Tuesday 23rd June will now take place on Wednesday 24th June
 - Statistics exam on Tuesday 23rd June will now take place on Friday 26th June
 - Maths Paper 1 on Wednesday 24th June will now take place on Thursday 25th June

Please note Friday 26th June will be a normal school day.
