Weekend Closures of Reddings Lane

What's Happening, Where and When?

What: Full weekend closures to through traffic.

Where: Reddings Lane at its junction with Olton Boulevard West

When: Weekends, from 7pm on Friday evenings until 6am Monday mornings.

How long: From Friday 8th February for up to <u>four</u> weekends.

Works Information

We will be carrying out works associated with the Birmingham City Council Battery Way Extension scheme, including the installation of drainage systems and cable ducting across Reddings Lane.

Works will be carried out throughout the weekends, starting on Friday 8th February, for up to four consecutive weekends, and will include night time works.

While we are working, there may be the risk of noise, however our teams will use all possible measures, for example ensuring unused machinery is not left running, to reduce noise nuisance. The operation to break out the existing road surface will cease by 11pm on Friday evening and by 7pm on other evenings and will not re-commence until 7am, other operations will continue through the night.

Traffic Information

During the affected weekends, Reddings Lane will be closed between Formans Road and Weston Road. Olton Boulevard West will be closed from Matlock Road to its junction with Reddings Lane. Signed diversion routes will be in place.

For vehicular access to properties within the closure extents:

Access will be maintained via gatemen stationed at each closure point at Formans Road, Weston Lane and Matlock Road.

For residents accessing properties on Olton Boulevard West: Please only approach via Olton Boulevard West.

For access to properties on Reddings Lane numbers 150 and below: Please only approach via Weston Lane/Reddings Lane (east)

For access to properties on Reddings Lane numbers 267 and above: Please only approach via Formans Road/Reddings Lane (west)

<u>Please note that there will be no through route through the Reddings Lane/Olton Boulevard West junction during these closures.</u>

Pedestrian routes through the junction and Bus route 36 will be maintained throughout.

We hope this information is helpful and we apologise for any inconvenience these essential works may cause. We will make every effort to minimise any unnecessary disruption. Furthermore, those working on site will be briefed on working responsibly in the local community.
