Dear Year 7 – 9 Parent(s) and Carer(s)

I hope that you are keeping safe and well.

The latest government guidance has stated that secondary schools such as ours should only open to pupils in Year 10 from Monday 15th June on a part time basis.

This means that all pupils in years 7 – 9 should continue to stay and work at home using the resources on the school website - VLE. <a href="https://www.yardleys-vle.com/">https://www.yardleys-vle.com/</a>

From today we have improved our home learning pages so that it is easier to navigate for pupils and parents. We have also included audio visual resources from teachers explaining the work pupils need to complete at home. In order to check that pupils are learning the set work we have increased the FrogPlay quizzes to two per subject every week. The maths IXL homework remains at four units per week.

Please can your support your child to complete as much work as possible whilst they are at home. Please note there are no sanctions for not completing this work but it is important that pupils do try to keep up with as much of their education as possible.
